ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 –

THE A1 TRUNK ROAD (NEWARK-ON-TRENT)
(TEMPORARY RESTRICTION AND PROHIBITION
OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2010

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State for Transport has made an Order on the A1 Trunk Road at Newark-on-Trent in the County of Nottinghamshire to allow resurfacing work to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to -

- (a) impose a 50 miles per hour speed restriction on the northbound carriageway of A1 from a point 1500 metres south of its junction with the slip road leading to Beacon Hill Road to that slip road;
- (b) close the northbound carriageway of A1 from its junction with the slip road leading to Beacon Hill Road to its junction with the slip road leading from its roundabout junction with the A46 and B6166;
- (c) close the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the A46 from Beacon Hill Road; and
- (d) close the layby adjacent to the northbound carriageway of the A1 approximately 1200 metres north of the slip road described at (c) above.

The work will be carried out over night between 20.00 hours and 06.00 hours and is expected to start on Thursday 4 March 2010 and continue for seven nights. The Order will come into force on 1 March 2010.

Vehicles being used by the emergency services will be exempt from the speed restriction and closures and vehicles being used in connection with the works will be exempt from the closures.

Diversion routes via Beckingham Road and the A17 will be well signed.
