

**HIGHWAYS AGENCY****ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 –****SECTION 14(1)(a)****THE A52 TRUNK ROAD (SAXONDALE,  
NOTTINGHAMSHIRE) (TEMPORARY RESTRICTION  
AND PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2010**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State for Transport intends to make an Order on the A52 Trunk Road at Saxondale in the County of Nottinghamshire to allow carriageway improvement work to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to -

- (a) impose a 40 miles per hour speed restriction on the A52 from a point 207 metres east of its junction with Oatfield Lane to its roundabout junction with the A46 and Nottingham Road (Saxondale Roundabout); and
- (b) close the layby adjacent to -
  - (i) the eastbound carriageway of the A52 approximately 550 metres east of Oatfield Lane; and
  - (ii) the westbound carriageway of the A52 approximately 450 metres east of Henson Lane.

The work is expected to start on Monday 5 April 2010 and last for eighteen months. The Order will come into force on 2 April 2010.

Vehicles being used by the emergency services will be exempt from the speed restriction and layby closures and vehicles being used in connection with the works will be exempt from the layby closures.
