

THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (NEWARK CASTLE LEVEL CROSSING, B6326 GREAT NORTH ROAD, NEWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2010 NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order, under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effects will be: Vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding in the following length of road at Newark in the District of Newark and Sherwood:-

B6326 Great North Road, from a point 30 metres north west of the north western level crossing barrier to a point 30 metres south east of the southern eastern crossing barrier.

IT IS INTENDED that the prohibition respecting the above road or roads will apply as follows:-

- (a) From 22.30 hours on Monday, May 10, 2010, until 05.00 hours on Tuesday, May 11, 2010, inclusive.
- (b) From 22.30 hours on Tuesday, May 11, 2010, until 05.00 hours on Wednesday, May 12, 2010, inclusive.
- (c) From 22.30 hours on Thursday, May 13, 2010, until 05.00 hours on Friday, May 14, 2010, inclusive.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the alternative routes available will be via B6326 Great North Road - A46(T) - B6166 Lincoln Road - B6166 North Gate - B6166 Bar Gate - B6326 Beast Market Hill and vice versa.

The Order will come into force on Monday, May 10, 2010, and any prohibition in it shall apply on that day and any subsequent day when necessary to enable works to be carried out. The Order shall continue in force until the works are completed (within a maximum period of 18 months).

The prohibition is required to carry out essential rail track maintenance work.
